

COVID-19 TESTING: CONTRA COSTA CO.

Thank you for recent visit to Epic Care. Please use the information below to find the fastest and most convenient COVID-19 testing details for Alameda County:

1. Use the online appointment tool provided by City Health for all Bay Area residents: <https://bayareacovid19testing.com/> to schedule an appointment at a location nearest you. The appointment tool provides real-time availability, and results can be returned in as little as 15 minutes with no cost to you.
 2. Call (844) 421-0804 to get a fast, convenient, drive-up COVID-19 test nearest you. Appointments are required and available 7 days a week. To schedule an appointment online, visit www.cchealth.org/coronavirus. Locations include:

- Once scheduled, please visit the appropriate drive-up location for testing. Testing will be at no cost to you and will be billed through your health insurance or free if you do not have coverage.
 - Test results will be provided directly to you within 24 – 48 hours. Until then, out of precaution, please continue to self-isolate and practice proper hand hygiene.
 - For questions about the status of your results, please call 844-421-0804.
 - Please contact your Physician to inform them of your test results.

If your doctor placed an order for COVID-19 testing and you are part of the JMH network, you may also use the JMH mobile site specimen collection service for COVID-19.

- Call (925) 952-2800 to schedule a lab appointment at one of the testing locations.

 - JMH, Walnut Creek OPC - 1450 Treat Blvd, Walnut Creek, CA
- Patients are required to wear a face mask and have their insurance card and ID ready.
- Patients will drive up to the mobile testing site in the parking lot at the scheduled time and location, remaining in their cars for specimen collection.
